QURBANI DRIVE 2025

Spreading Joy, Sharing Blessings – In Partnership with Jigsaw Charity

This Eid-ul-Adha, SCWF collaborated with Jigsaw Charity to carry out a large-scale Qurbani Drive 2025, bringing the spirit of sacrifice and generosity to those who need it most.

Together, we ensured that families struggling with poverty could celebrate Eid with dignity and joy. Through this partnership, both beef and lamb meat were distributed in well-prepared packages to communities across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Project Details:

- Total Animals Sacrificed: 17 Cows and 25 Sheep
- Total Meat Distributed:
 - Beef: 1,945 kg
 - Lamb Meat: 506 kg
- Total Beneficiaries:
 - 650+ families received 3 kg beef each
 - 250+ families received 2 kg lamb meat each

The distribution was conducted with care and organization to ensure fairness and maximum outreach. For many, this was their only opportunity to enjoy meat during the festive season – a reminder of how collective compassion can truly change lives. Together, we turned sacrifice into sustenance, and celebration into shared joy.



KIDS FUN DAY AND EID GIFTS DISTRIBUTION

A Day of Joy and Celebration for Over 400 Children – In Collaboration with Jigsaw Charity

In the spirit of Eid, SCWF in partnership with Jigsaw Charity organized a heartwarming Eid Gift Distribution and Recreational Event for 400+ underprivileged children at a local park in Peshawar.

The event was filled with laughter, games, and joyful moments – offering these children not just gifts, but memories to cherish. From face painting and fun games to delicious food and storytelling corners, every detail was planned to make the children feel seen, valued, and celebrated.



Each child received toys and sweets and spent a day filled with joy, games, and celebration – a rare and precious experience for many of them.

This event wasn't just about giving – it was about belonging, inclusion, and restoring childhood joy in lives too often burdened by hardship.

Together, we turned Eid into a festival of hope and happiness – showing these children that they are not forgotten, but deeply cared for.

WATER HAND PUMPS

PROVIDING ACCESS TO CLEAN WATER

In May 2025, SCWF installed 2 new hand pumps in underserved areas, benefiting 5 families and a total of 36 individuals. These installations have provided reliable access to clean and safe drinking water, improving daily living conditions for the communities served.

This effort is part of our ongoing commitment to enhancing health, hygiene, and overall well-being in vulnerable regions.



Monthly Ration Package

DELIVERING HOPE TO 50 DESERVING FAMILIES

At Street Children Welfare Foundation, we believe no one should go to bed hungry. Our Monthly Food Ration Project provides essential groceries to over 100 families each month, delivering nourishment, relief, and hope to those in need.

Project Highlights:

- Supporting 54+ Families Every Month
- Each Food Basket Costs Just PKR 9,000/-
- Bringing smiles and dignity to countless households

ZAKAT DISTRIBUTION – JUNE 2025

In June 2025, a total of PKR 80,000 in zakat was distributed among 8 deserving families, with each family receiving PKR 10,000 to help meet their essential needs.

- Total Beneficiaries: 8 families
- Total Amount Distributed: PKR 80,000
- Amount Received per Family: PKR 10,000

Livelihood Support Programme

A NEW BEGINNING FOR RAHIM BAKHSH

Under our Livelihood Support Programme, SCWF renovated a struggling barber's shop that was in poor condition and affecting his income. We gave the space a complete makeover with new equipment, furniture, and accessories, helping him restart his business with dignity. This initiative wasn't just about a shop – it was about restoring hope and enabling self-reliance.

TANDOOR SHOP

At Street Children Welfare Foundation, our Tandoor Project is dedicated to providing fresh, daily meals to families in need. With three active tandoor locations, we are committed to expanding this initiative to reach even more deserving families in the near future.

Project Highlights:

- Daily Meal Support for Over 300 Families (providing *Rotti* Bread).
- 3 Operational Locations.
- A growing project aimed at fighting hunger and restoring hope.



ORPHANAGE SUPPORT

SUPPORTING DREAMS THROUGH EDUCATION

As part of our Orphanage Support Program, SCWF extended support to orphaned students at AMN School, Swabi, by providing essential ration packages, stationery supplies, and continued guidance in mental well-being and personality development.

This holistic approach ensures that vulnerable children not only have access to nutritious food but also the tools and confidence they need to thrive academically and emotionally.

FRIDAY FOOD TRUCK

SERVING WARM MEALS WITH DIGNITY

In June 2025, the Friday Food Truck continued its mission in Peshawar, distributing hot, nutritious meals across multiple underserved areas. This month, over 500 individuals were directly served – including daily wage workers, families, and patients from rehabilitation centers.

By reaching those who often go unnoticed, this initiative remains a symbol of compassionate care, ensuring that the end of each week brings warmth, dignity, and nourishment to those who need it most.

WHEELCHAIR SUPPORT PROGRAMME

RESTORING MOBILITY AND DIGNITY

As part of our commitment to supporting individuals with physical challenges, SCWF distributed 25 wheelchairs to deserving beneficiaries in need. These wheelchairs were provided to people who lacked access to basic mobility aids, enabling them to move independently and with dignity.

This initiative reflects our belief that mobility is a right, not a privilege – and through your support, we continue to empower lives, one wheelchair at a time.



MEDICAL CARE PROGRAMME

SUPPORTING RECOVERY AND INDEPENDENCE

Through our Medical Care Programme, SCWF extended vital support to Muhammad Zaman, a leg amputee in need of urgent assistance. With limited financial resources and mobility, his daily life was severely impacted.

SCWF stepped in to provide him with a new prosthetic leg, enabling him to walk again and regain independence. This initiative reflects our continued commitment to delivering essential medical aid to those in need, helping individuals reclaim their dignity and rebuild their lives with confidence.



SADAQAH ANIMAL SACRIFICE

SHARING BLESSINGS WITH THE NEEDY

SCWF carried out a Sadaqah sacrifice of one cow and one sheep, with the intention of bringing relief and nourishment to those in need. The meat was carefully packaged and distributed among underprivileged families, ensuring they received a share of this charitable offering.

This initiative highlights our dedication to uplifting vulnerable communities through meaningful acts of compassion and generosity.



FREE MEDICAL CAMP

DELIVERING HEALTHCARE TO REMOTE COMMUNITIES

The Street Children Welfare Foundation, in collaboration with Acts of Kindness Pakistan, successfully organized a free medical camp in Leepa Valley – a remote area with extremely limited access to basic healthcare services.

Staffed by expert medical professionals, the camp provided free checkups, essential medications, and diagnostic lab tests to the local population. The initiative aimed to bridge the healthcare gap in this underserved region and ensure that vital medical support reached those who need it most.



APPROXIMATELY 1,200 PATIENTS WERE ATTENDED TO DURING THE CAMP, REFLECTING OUR ONGOING COMMITMENT TO DELIVERING ACCESSIBLE AND COMPASSIONATE HEALTHCARE TO MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES.



JIGSAW LIVELIHOOD SUPPORT PROGRAMME

BUILDING FUTURES THROUGH SMALL BUSINESSES

In a landmark initiative under our Livelihood Support Programme, the Street Children Welfare Foundation, in collaboration with Jigsaw Charity, successfully organized a Mega Livelihood Drive across Peshawar and Islamabad – aimed at empowering skilled yet underserved individuals through sustainable business opportunities.

Through this impactful event, we supported the establishment of 24 small businesses, 12 in each city. Every recipient was carefully selected based on skill, need, potential, and provided with the necessary tools, inventory, and setup to launch their venture with dignity.

This initiative was more than just economic aid – it was an investment in self-reliance, confidence, and long-term change. By helping individuals take control of their livelihood, we are paving the way for families to rise above poverty and build a better future.



The Mega Livelihood Drive stands as a powerful example of how collective action can transform lives and ignite hope in the hearts of those ready to thrive – when simply given a chance.

Looking Ahead: Upcoming Initiatives – July 2025

As we continue our mission to uplift those in need, we are pleased to share a glimpse of our upcoming initiatives for July 2025, aimed at fostering long-term impact and dignity across vulnerable communities:

- **Orphanage Support** – Providing orphaned children with monthly ration packs, school supplies, and mentorship for personality development, ensuring they grow in a safe, nurturing environment.
- **Food & Ration Distribution** – Extending monthly ration packs and freshly prepared meals to families battling food insecurity across various regions.
- **Livelihood Support** – Identifying skilled individuals and providing them with resources and tools to launch or revive small businesses, promoting financial independence.
- **Zakat Distribution** – Offering timely zakat support to deserving families, widows, and patients to help meet their urgent financial needs.
- **Wheelchair Distribution** – Delivering wheelchairs to individuals with physical challenges, restoring their mobility and independence.
- **Miles of Thirst – Water Pump Initiative** – Launching a dedicated drive to **install 10 new hand pumps** in a water-scarce village, ensuring access to safe and clean drinking water for the entire community.
- **Plantation Drive** – Conducting a large-scale plantation campaign to promote environmental sustainability, combat climate change, and create greener, healthier surroundings in our project areas.
