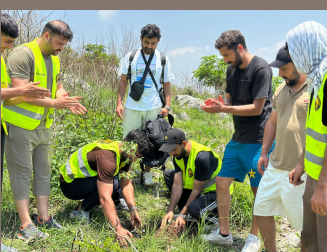
A CHARITY STRIVING TO SERVE EVERYONE

PLANTATION DRIVE 2025

Planting Hope, Growing Change – In Collaboration with Islamabad Wildlife Management Board

In July 2025, SCWF partnered with the Islamabad Wildlife Management Board to conduct a Plantation Drive aimed at promoting environmental sustainability and raising awareness about the importance of green spaces.

Held in Islamabad, this initiative brought together volunteers, students, and environmental advocates to take collective action against deforestation and climate change by planting a diverse range of native trees.

Project Highlights:

- **Location:** Islamabad
- **Partners Involved:** Islamabad Wildlife Management Board
- **Trees Planted:** 100 +
- **Purpose:** Combat deforestation, promote environmental awareness, and restore natural ecosystems

This drive not only contributed to a cleaner and greener environment but also encouraged community ownership and responsibility toward nature. Energized by the positive response, SCWF now plans to expand this initiative to more cities across Pakistan, continuing our efforts to plant hope and grow a better future.



DRUG REHABILITATION PROGRAMME

Healing Lives, Restoring Hope in Collaboration with Jigsaw Charity

In July 2025, SCWF, in collaboration with Jigsaw Charity, continued its efforts under the Drug Rehabilitation Programme at Khyber Rehabilitation Center, an initiative focused on transforming the lives of individuals struggling with drug addiction.

This ongoing project provides a structured and compassionate rehabilitation journey that begins with detoxification, followed by medical supervision, group and individual therapy, religious counseling, and mental health support. The goal is not just recovery, but reintegration into society with restored dignity and purpose.

Project Highlights:

- Location: Khyber Rehabilitation Center
- Partners: Jigsaw Charity
- Services: Detox, therapy, spiritual counseling, mental health support
- Impact: 15 successful recoveries in July
- Support: Hygiene kits, motivational interaction, post-rehab follow-up

SCWF's team visited the center to meet patients, share words of encouragement, and distribute hygiene kits – reinforcing that they are not alone in their journey.



The programme includes **detoxification, medical supervision, therapy sessions, and religious counseling**, aiming to restore not just health, but dignity and purpose. This month, **15 patients** suffering from severe drug addiction successfully completed their rehabilitation and were reintegrated into society.

This ongoing initiative reflects our continued commitment to healing lives and rebuilding futures through care, consistency, and community support.

Widow Relief & Empowerment Initiative

STANDING WITH STRENGTH AND COMPASSION

Through our Widow Relief & Empowerment Initiative, SCWF provides monthly ration support and financial assistance to widows facing economic hardship. This programme aims to ease their daily struggles while promoting dignity, stability, and self-reliance.

By supporting these women, we're not only addressing urgent needs – we're helping them rebuild their lives with strength and hope.



Livelihood Support Programme

REBUILDING LIVELIHOODS, RESTORING DIGNITY

Under our Livelihood Support Programme, SCWF extended support to Siyab Khan, the owner of a small general store that had fallen into disrepair and lacked basic inventory. Recognizing his determination to provide for his family, we renovated the shop and fully restocked it with essential grocery items, allowing him to reopen with confidence.

This effort was not just about reopening a store – it was about empowering a hardworking individual to stand on his feet and rebuild a future with pride.

DIGNITY MEAL PROJECT

At Street Children Welfare Foundation, our Dignity Meal Project continues to provide fresh, daily roti to families struggling with food insecurity. With three fully operational tandoor points, we now serve over 300 families daily, offering a simple yet vital source of nourishment.

- 3 Active Tandoor Locations
- A growing initiative committed to fighting hunger and uplifting lives, one meal at a time.



ORPHANAGE SUPPORT PROGRAMME

FROM ORPHANHOOD TO OPPORTUNITY

As part of our Orphanage Support Program, SCWF continued its efforts at AMN School, Swabi, by providing ration packs, educational stationery, and support in mental well-being and personal development to orphaned children.

This initiative ensures that these young minds not only have access to food and learning materials but also grow with confidence, care, and a sense of belonging.

FRIDAY FOOD TRUCK

HUNGER ENDS WHERE KINDNESS BEGINS

In July 2025, the Friday Food Truck continued its weekly mission across KPK, delivering hot, nutritious meals to those facing hunger and hardship. This month, over 600 individuals were served – including laborers, low-income families, and underprivileged communities

Each Friday, this initiative offers more than food – it brings relief, dignity, and a reminder that they are not alone, turning the end of every week into a moment of care and connection.

WHEELCHAIR SUPPORT PROGRAMME

RESTORING MOBILITY AND DIGNITY

In July 2025, SCWF provided 30 wheelchairs to individuals living with physical disabilities, many of whom had no means of mobility before. This essential support is helping them regain independence, access education or work, and move through life with dignity.

Each wheelchair delivered is a step toward inclusion – a reminder that every person deserves the freedom to move, to live, and to thrive. With your continued support, we are breaking barriers and moving lives forward.



MEDICAL SUPPORT PROGRAMME

RESTORING SIGHT, RENEWING LIVES

As part of our Medical Support Programme, SCWF provided essential medical assistance to 10 patients suffering from cataract-related vision impairment. With limited access to healthcare, these individuals had been silently battling deteriorating eyesight that affected their daily lives and livelihoods.

Through timely intervention and support, they received proper diagnosis, surgical treatment, and post-operative care, allowing them to recover their sight and return to normal life with renewed confidence.

Project Details:

- **Number of Patients Treated:** 10
- **Medical Condition:** Cataract (eye disease)
- **Support Provided:** Eye surgeries, medications, and follow-up care
- **Impact:** Restored vision, improved quality of life, and increased independence

This initiative reflects our unwavering commitment to ensuring access to life-changing healthcare for those who need it most.



CLEAN DRINKING WATER PROJECT: MILES OF THIRST

FROM DISTANT HARDSHIPS TO DAILY RELIEF

In response to the severe water scarcity faced by underserved communities, SCWF launched the Miles of Thirst Initiative – a long-term effort to provide sustainable access to clean and safe drinking water in remote areas.

Under this initiative, we aim to install 10 hand pumps across an entire village, where residents have long struggled with unsafe and unreliable water sources. These pumps will not only reduce the burden of walking miles each day for water but will also improve health, hygiene, and daily life for entire families.

Project Details:

- **Hand Pumps Installed:** 10
- **Location:** Village Mathra, District Peshawar, KPK
- **Households Benefited:** Up to 30
- **Total Individuals Impacted:** 150+
- **Purpose:** Reliable access to safe drinking water, improved hygiene, reduced illness

Looking Ahead: Upcoming Initiatives – August 2025

As we continue our mission to uplift those in need, we are pleased to share a glimpse of our upcoming initiatives for August 2025, focused on creating sustainable impact and restoring dignity across vulnerable communities:

- **Orphanage Support** – Providing orphaned children with monthly ration packs, school supplies, and mentorship for personality development, ensuring they grow in a safe, nurturing environment.
- **Food & Ration Distribution** – Continuing to distribute monthly ration packs and freshly prepared meals to families facing food insecurity across various regions.
- **Livelihood Support** – Identifying and equipping skilled individuals with the tools and resources needed to launch or strengthen small businesses, promoting long-term financial independence.
- **Widow Support Programme** – Offering monthly ration and financial assistance to widows, helping them meet essential needs with dignity and stability.
- **Rehabilitation Programme** – Providing ongoing care, counseling, and reintegration support for individuals recovering from substance abuse, enabling them to rebuild their lives.
- **Skill Support Initiative** – Supporting underprivileged women by offering training and resources in employable skills, helping them become financially independent.
- **Wheelchair Distribution** – Delivering wheelchairs to individuals with physical disabilities, helping them regain mobility, confidence, and freedom of movement.
- **Solar Water Tank Project** – Constructing a solar-powered water tank with a proper filtration system, providing a sustainable and clean drinking water solution to a community facing water scarcity.
