## Widow Relief & Empowerment Initiative

*TURNING VULNERABILITY INTO STRENGTH*

At SCWF, we believe widows deserve more than just survival – they deserve the opportunity to live with dignity and purpose. Through our Widow Relief & Empowerment Initiative, we provide monthly ration support and financial aid, ensuring that women facing loss and hardship are not left to struggle alone.

This programme is not charity alone; it is about restoring confidence, nurturing independence, and creating pathways for self-reliance. Each act of support becomes a step toward transforming vulnerability into resilience and grief into strength.



## Sadaqah Meat Distribution

*SHARING BLESSINGS THROUGH SACRIFICE*

In August 2025, SCWF carried out the sacrifice of a cow as Sadaqah and distributed the meat among deserving families in need. The fresh meat was carefully packaged and shared to ensure that vulnerable households could enjoy a nourishing meal, many of whom rarely have access to it.

### Project Details:

- Animal Sacrificed: 1 Cow
- Total Meat Distributed: 125+ kg
- Beneficiaries: Multiple underprivileged families across the community

This act of compassion served as a reminder that Sadaqah is not only a spiritual duty but also a means of bringing relief and dignity to those struggling with hunger.





## Projects In August

### **ORPHANAGE SUPPORT PROGRAMME**

#### *NURTURING HOPE THROUGH CARE AND EDUCATION*

As part of our Orphanage Support Program, SCWF extended continued support to the students of AMN School, Swabi, by providing monthly ration packs, essential stationery, and guidance in mental well-being and personality development.

This initiative goes beyond meeting basic needs – it creates an environment where orphaned children can learn, grow, and thrive with dignity and confidence.

With the steadfast generosity of our donors, we remain committed to uplifting orphaned and underprivileged children, ensuring they have the tools and encouragement to build brighter, more secure futures.

### **DIGNITY MEAL PROJECT**

At Street Children Welfare Foundation, the Dignity Meal Project continues to be a lifeline for families battling food insecurity. Through our three active tandoor points, we provide fresh, daily roti to over 300 families every day, ensuring that no family goes without this most basic necessity. What may seem small – a simple roti – carries the power to ease hunger, restore dignity, and bring comfort to those who need it most.

### **FRIDAY FOOD TRUCK**

#### *SERVING WARMTH BEYOND MEALS*

Throughout August 2025, the Friday Food Truck continued to roll into underserved areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, offering warm, freshly prepared meals to those who often go without. This month, the initiative reached over 650 people, including daily wage earners, struggling households, and vulnerable communities.

For many, these meals are more than food – they are a gesture of care and solidarity, bringing relief at the close of each week and reminding them that their needs and dignity matter.



# Projects In August

## CLEAN DRINKING WATER PROJECT

*BRINGING LIFE THROUGH EVERY DROP*

In August 2025, SCWF continued its mission to ensure safe water access by installing 3 new water pumps in underserved areas. These pumps have become a lifeline for families who previously relied on unsafe or distant sources for their daily needs.

### Project Details:

- Water Pumps Installed: 3
- Households Served: 6
- Total Beneficiaries: 36 family members

Through this initiative, we are not just providing water – we are delivering health, dignity, and relief, ensuring that every drop contributes to a better quality of life.



## RATION SUPPORT PROGRAMME

*FILLING EMPTY KITCHENS WITH FOOD, AND EMPTY HEARTS WITH HOPE*

Through our Ration Support Programme, SCWF remains dedicated to supporting families who struggle to meet their most basic food needs. Rising costs and limited income often leave many households unable to provide consistent meals, which is why this initiative plays such a vital role in their lives.

In August 2025, we provided 50 deserving families with monthly ration packs, each containing essential groceries such as flour, rice, pulses, oil, sugar, and other daily necessities. These packs not only help reduce hunger but also ease the financial burden, allowing families to focus on other important needs such as education, health, and stability.

### Project Details:

- **Families Supported:** 50
- **Support Provided:** Monthly ration packs with essential groceries
- **Impact:** Strengthened food security, reduced hunger, and restored dignity to vulnerable households

Each ration pack is more than just food – it represents care, compassion, and hope, helping families move forward with strength despite the challenges they face.



## FLOOD RELIEF INITIATIVE 2025

### *STANDING WITH VICTIMS IN TIMES OF NEED*

In August 2025, SCWF visited the flood-affected areas of Buner, where heavy rains and overflowing streams had damaged dozens of homes, displaced families, and destroyed crops and livestock. With many households losing their primary source of livelihood, entire communities were left struggling without food, clean water, or medical care.

Our team conducted a detailed survey to identify the most urgent requirements of the affected households. Based on this assessment, we are preparing to provide essential ration packs, medical support, and daily-use items to help families recover with dignity.

This initiative reflects our unwavering commitment to standing beside vulnerable communities in times of crisis. Beyond providing aid, we aim to help families regain stability, rebuild their livelihoods, and restore a sense of hope for the future. By addressing both immediate needs and long-term challenges, we strive to ensure that no one is left behind in the journey toward recovery.

## Looking Ahead: Upcoming Initiatives – September 2025

As we continue our mission to uplift those in need, we are pleased to share a glimpse of our upcoming initiatives for September 2025, focused on delivering sustainable impact and restoring dignity across vulnerable communities:

- **Orphanage Support** – Providing orphaned children with monthly ration packs, school supplies, and mentorship for personality development, ensuring they grow in a safe, nurturing environment.
- **Food & Ration Distribution** – Continuing to distribute monthly ration packs and freshly prepared meals to families facing food insecurity across various regions.
- **Livelihood Support** – Identifying and equipping skilled individuals with the tools and resources needed to launch or strengthen small businesses, promoting long-term financial independence.
- **Widow Support Programme** – Offering monthly ration and financial assistance to widows, helping them meet essential needs with dignity and stability.
- **Rehabilitation Programme** – Providing ongoing care, counseling, and reintegration support for individuals recovering from substance abuse, enabling them to rebuild their lives.
- **Skill Support Initiative** – Supporting underprivileged women by offering training and resources in employable skills, helping them become financially independent.
- **Wheelchair Distribution** – Delivering wheelchairs to individuals with physical disabilities, helping them regain mobility, confidence, and freedom of movement.
- **Solar Water Tank Project** – Constructing a solar-powered water tank with a proper filtration system, providing a sustainable and clean drinking water solution to a community facing water scarcity.
- **Ration & Cash Assistance** – Supporting 200 families with essential ration packs and financial aid to help them meet their daily needs with dignity.
- **Flood Relief Initiative** – Extending urgent aid, including ration packs, medical care, and daily essentials, to families displaced and devastated by the recent floods.
